Husch Blackwell Names Joe Glynias Chair Elect

TWO NEW EXECUTIVE BOARD MEMBERS ALSO ANNOUNCED, ALL EFFECTIVE APRIL 1

The partners of Husch Blackwell have elected Joe Glynias to serve as the firm's next Executive Board Chair, succeeding current Chair Catherine Hanaway, whose term ends March 31, 2024.

Glynias joined Husch Blackwell in 2003 and has been with the firm for his entire legal career. He served on the firm's Executive Board from 2015-2022.
