Over the next few months, he built a nationwide network of attorneys willing to mentor law students and recent J.D. grads—which formed the beginning of the now-nationwide Legal Mentor Network. Brian has since connected thousands of mentors and protégés through the program, personally mentored more than 1,000 individuals, and helped thousands of others obtain mentorship.

Alongside his love of mentoring, Brian is also enthusiastic about working with startups. He regularly meets with startup founders and assists them in connecting with investors and potential attorneys. An entrepreneur himself, Brian has founded startups of his own, including a company that has raised over \$4 million in outside capital. He understands the process of owning and growing a business, and he understands what clients' businesses mean to them.
